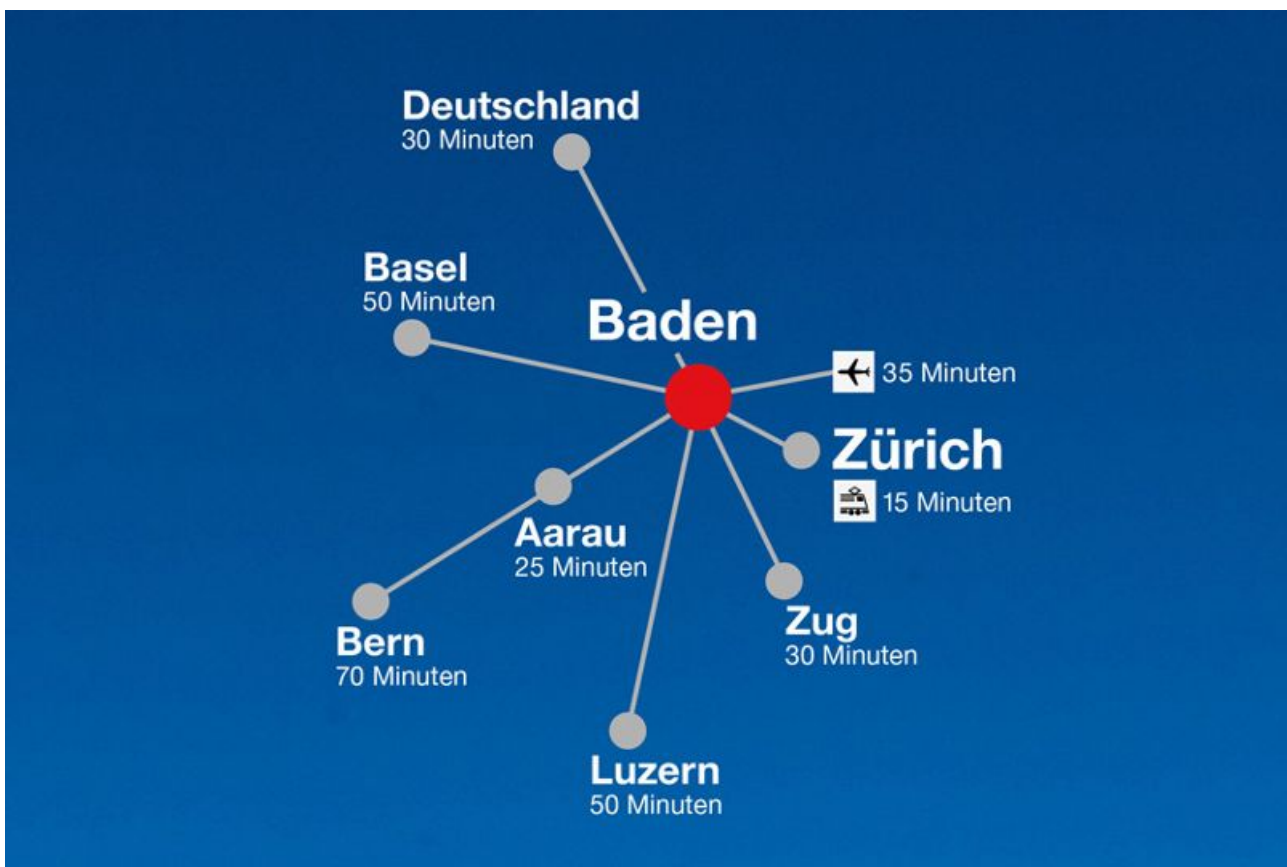


Central location (copy 1) (copy 1)

Baden is the urban centre for over 120,000 people in the middle of Switzerland's largest economic hub linking Zurich, Basel and Bern. Both the Zurich International Airport and Basel EuroAirport are easily accessible, making it possible to travel on business to major European cities and fly back on the same day. The border with Germany is only 25 km away.



Public Transport

The city is extremely well connected to the commuter and long-distance transport networks. Numerous bus lines and suburban trains run every ten minutes between the city and the surrounding areas. Direct trains running every half hour can reach Zurich's main railway station in just 15 minutes.

Private transport

The city is directly linked to Switzerland's main motorway networks with two junctions. Accessing the centre of Baden can be done very efficiently. Fourteen multi-storey car parks in the city centre offer over 3,500 parking

spaces featuring a parking guidance system.
