

## Inspiring work environment

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Thanks to its international makeup and close proximity to Zurich, Baden is both urbane and very open-minded. Nevertheless, relaxing green spaces are within easy walking distance of all workplaces – mostly because more than half of the city's surface area is covered by forest.



In addition to Baden's thermal baths with the highest mineral content in Switzerland, there are swimming pools, health centres, and dance and sports activities of all kinds, including curling and kubb. Shopping fans can take a pleasant stroll through the city centre's spacious pedestrian zone, with well over 200 shops and more than 80 restaurants. The large fresh food market on Saturdays attracts many people from all over the region to the picturesque old town.

It is a well-known fact that Baden's cultural and leisure scene is very vibrant, and its repeat top placements in this category in the Swiss City Ranking provide further proof. International festivals such as the Fantoche animated film festival and the Baden Blues Festival attract tens of thousands of visitors to the city every year.



Hotel guests can use public transport free of charge with the [Badener «Cityticket»](#). The “Badenfahrt” folk festival takes place every ten years – and more recently once every five years as well. It is one of the largest events in Switzerland and has been on the list of Swiss living traditions since 2017.
